

# Fitnessgram 9 Installation: District Windows 2008 Server

---

## *Are you prepared for Fitnessgram 9 installation?*

*Is Web Server (IIS) showing up under Roles Summary in the Server Manager?*

*Is .NET Framework 3.5 showing up as installed under Features Summary in the Server Manager?*

*Do you have Microsoft SQL Server 2005 (or higher) Enterprise or Standard Edition installed on this server?*

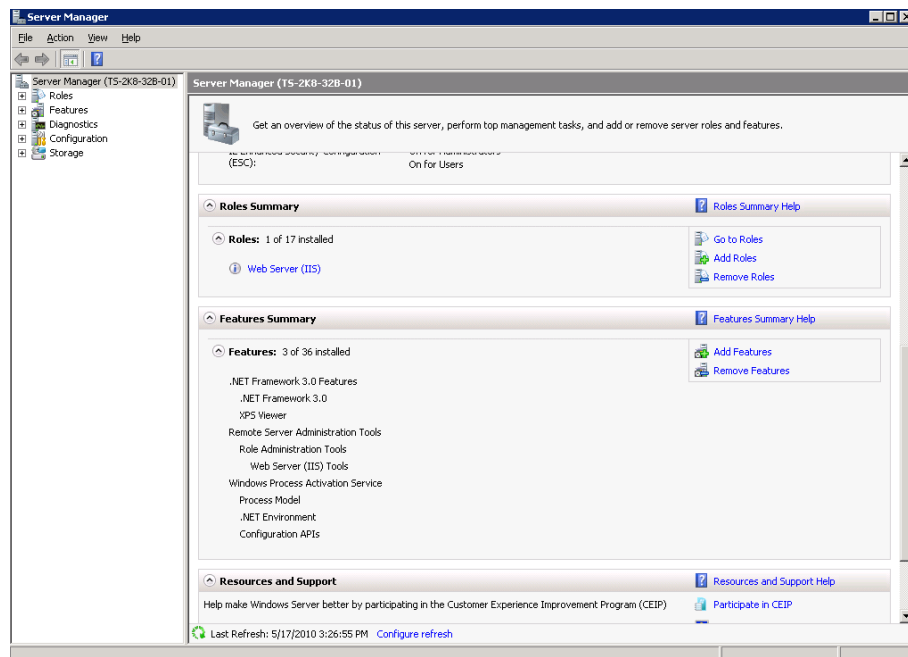
*Is the account doing the installation have full rights (including Create Database rights)?*

*If the answer to all four of these questions is yes, then please proceed with the installation of Fitnessgram 9.*

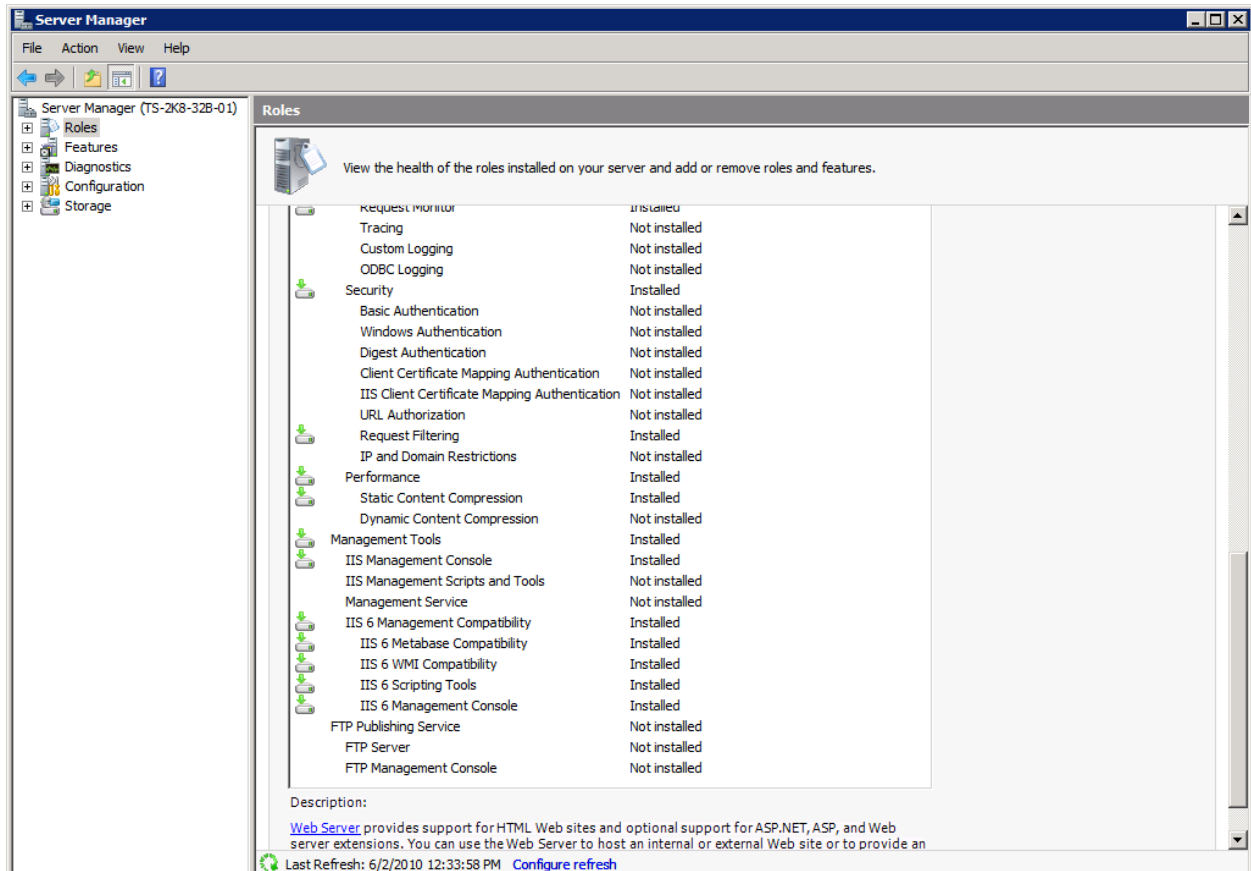
**Note:** *Fitnessgram 9 needs a dedicated server. It cannot be installed on a server that is running Cold Fusion. The application installs the website as the default website. Technical support does not offer support on making changes to the default website after installed.*

## Server Manager

If the server is ready for the installation of Fitnessgram 9, a Roles Summary Web Server (IIS) will appear in the Roles list and .NET Framework 3.0 will appear in the Features list.



If installing the program on a 64-bit system with IIS 7, you will need to check the Server Manager to be sure that IIS 6 Compatibility is installed.

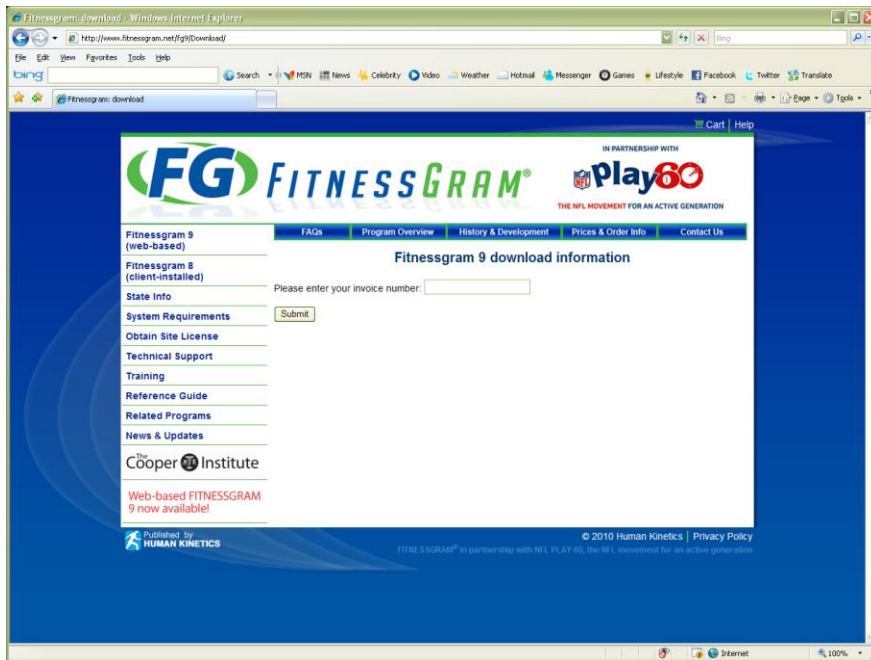


If installing on a 64-bit system, make sure that 32-bit support is enabled in IIS.

1. Right-click on the Application Pool and select **Advanced Settings...**
2. Change the **Enable 32-bit Applications** to **True** (if you want the application pool to spawn in a 32-bit mode).
3. Click OK.

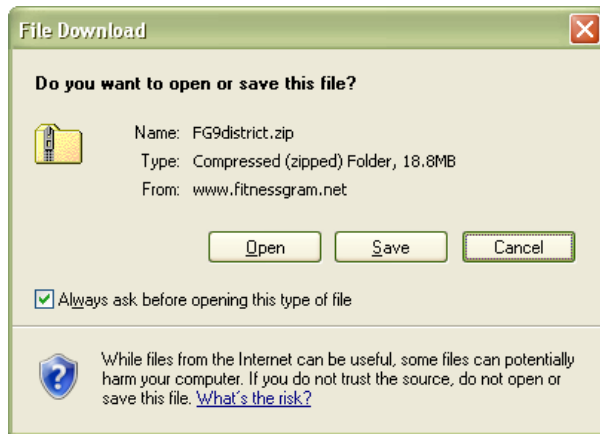
## Access to the Fitnessgram 9 installer

Take the invoice number from Human Kinetics for the purchase of Fitnessgram 9, go to [www.fitnessgram.net/fg9/Download](http://www.fitnessgram.net/fg9/Download), enter the number, and choose Submit.

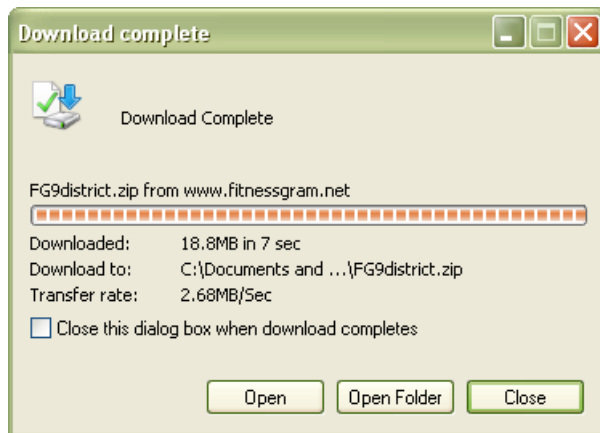


Choose the Fitnessgram 9—District version installer link. When the File Download screen appears, select Save and then choose to save it to your desktop or somewhere on the computer that is easily accessible.



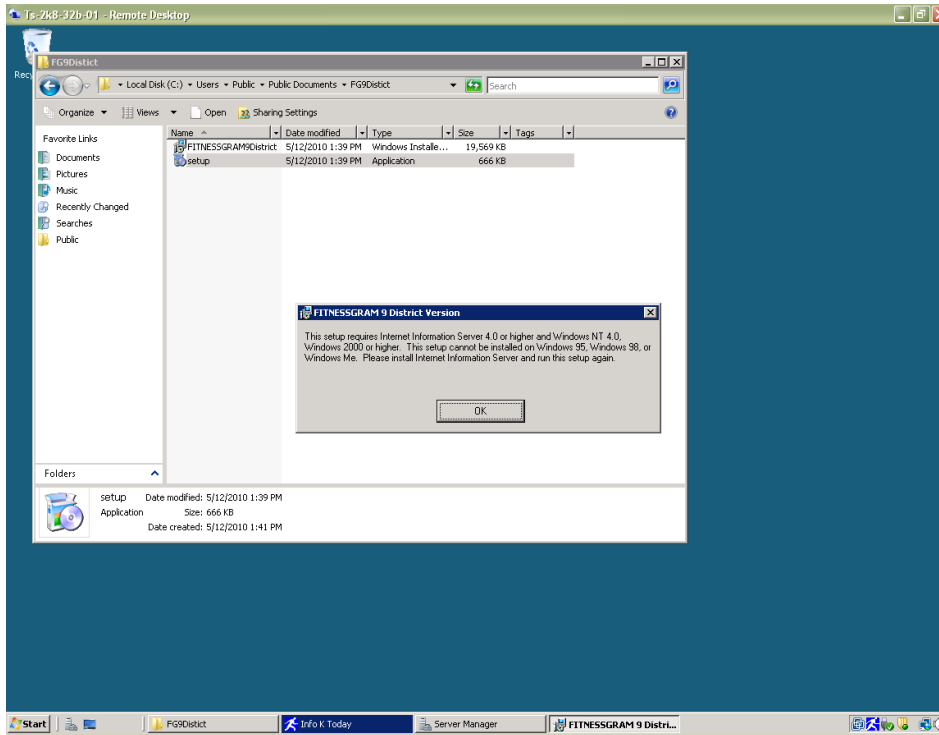


When the download is complete, close the screen.

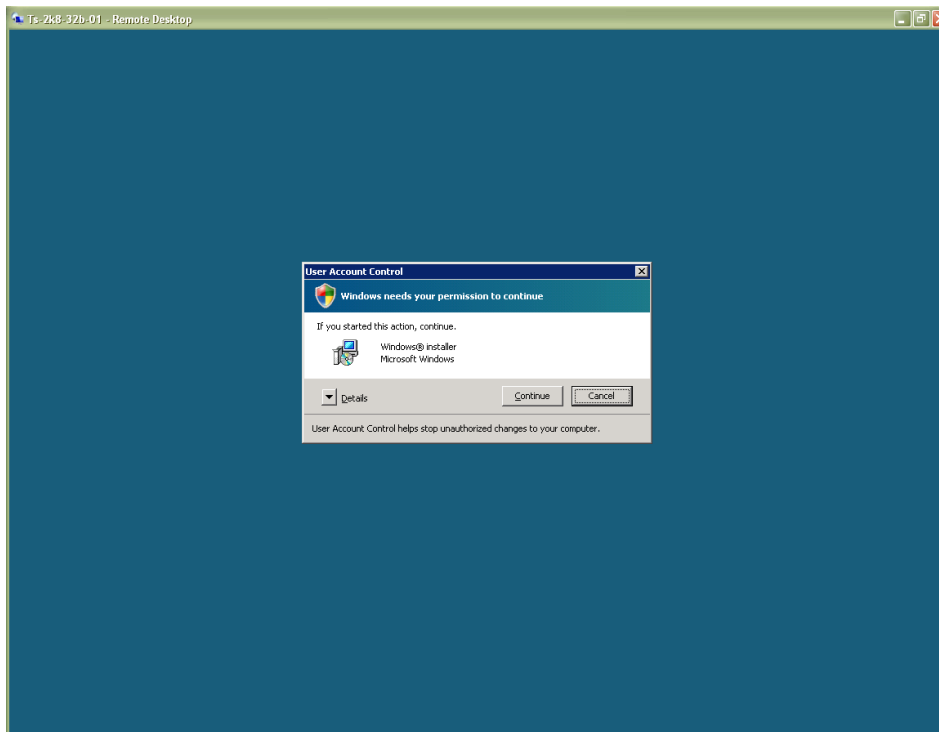


## Fitnessgram 9 Installer

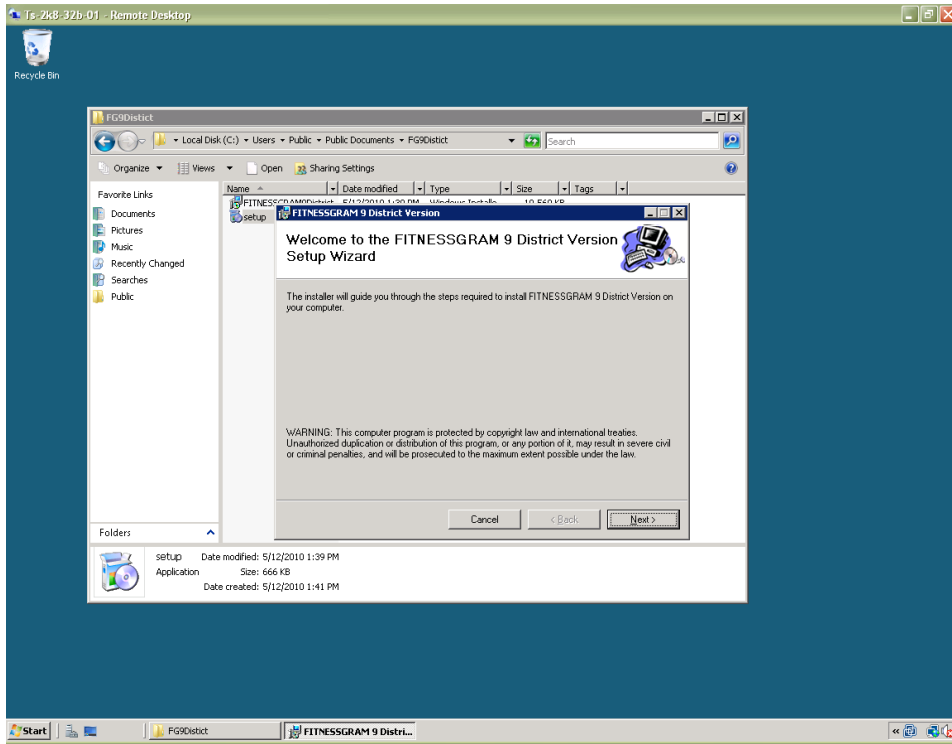
When choosing the Fitnessgram 9 installer and starting the installation process, there will be a prompt regarding the program requiring IIS.



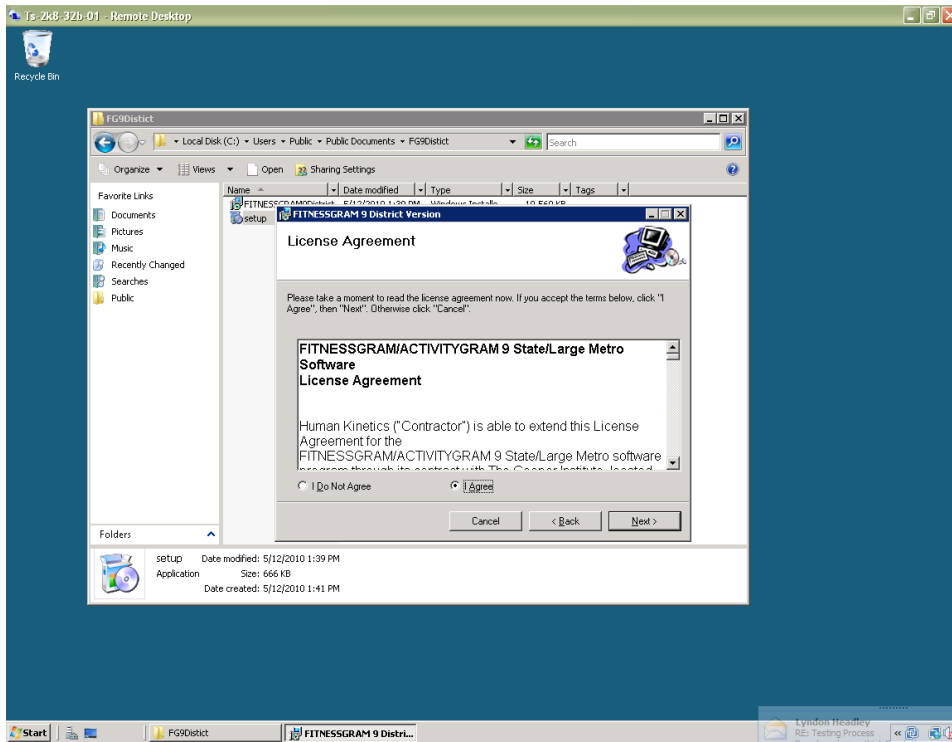
Windows will need your permission to continue.



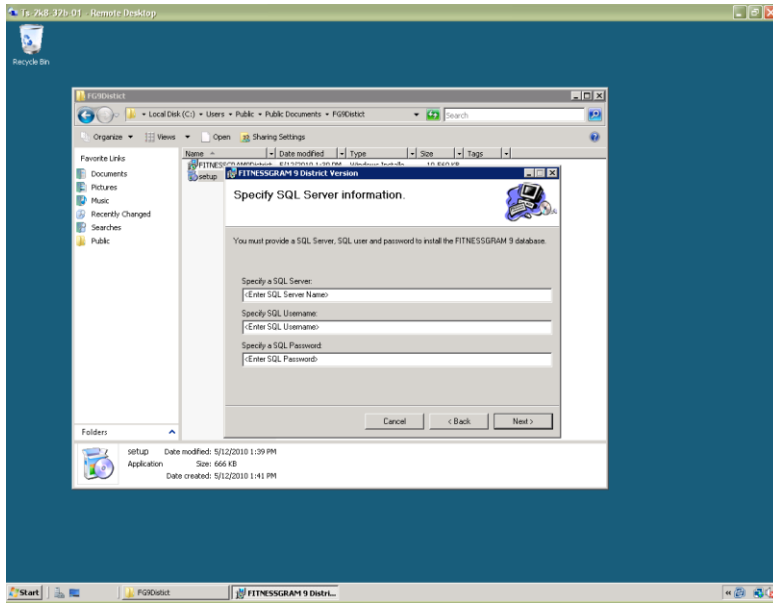
At the Setup Wizard screen, click Next.



On the License Agreement screen, select the button for Agree and then click Next.

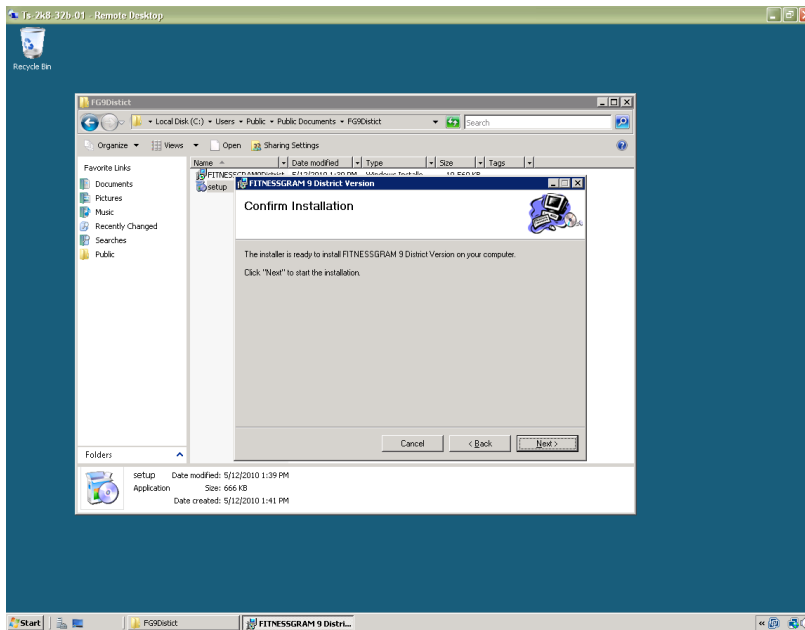


At the Specify SQL Server information screen, you must enter the name of the SQL server, the user name, and password for the server. This is not the FG9 login. Once the information is entered, click Next.

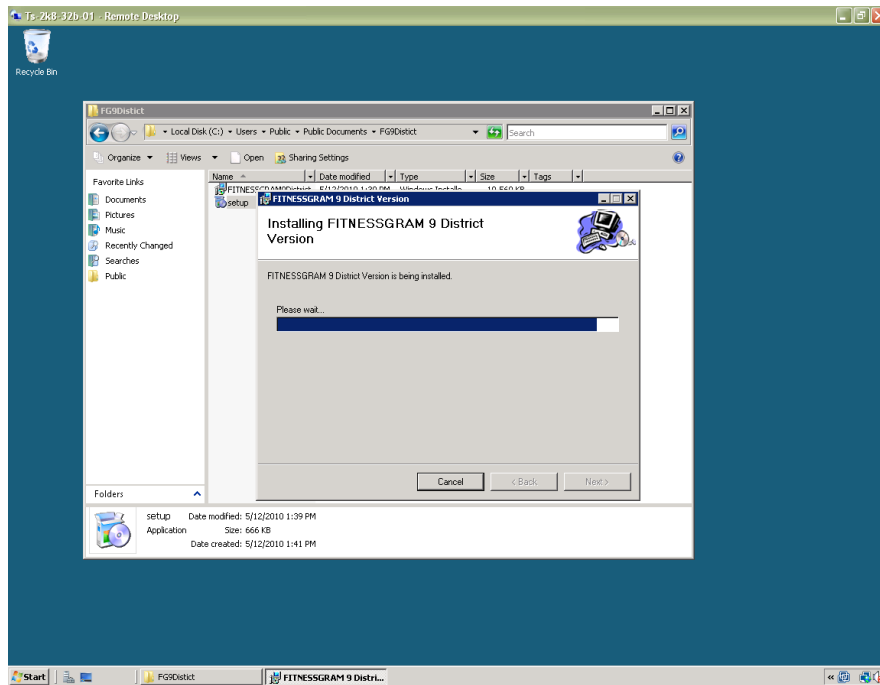


**Note:** If the server name, user name, and password are not entered, Fitnessgram 9 will not install. If the person doing the installation does not have this information, they will have to contact someone in their IT department or the SQL administrator for the district.

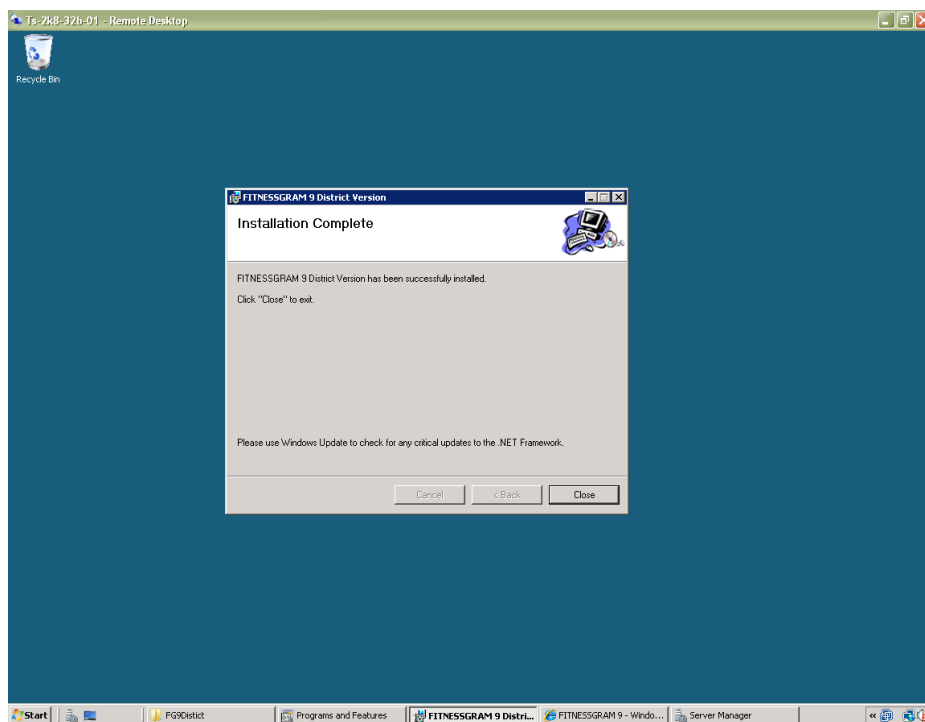
The installer will ask for confirmation that the installation should take place. Click on Next and the installation will begin.



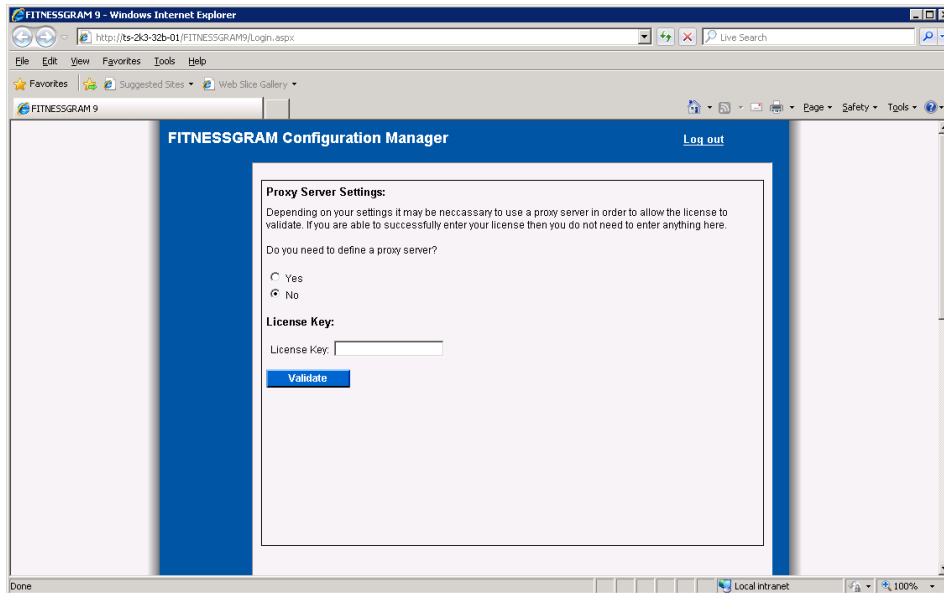
During the installation, a progress bar will display.



Installation is complete when the following screen will appear, and then you can close the screen.



The Fitnessgram Configuration Manager will open automatically, and you will enter your license key and select Validate.



Once you see the message that confirms your license key has been validated, it is very important that you place the cursor in the URL field at the top of the page. This is commonly referred to as the address bar. Depending on the browser you are using, the URL will be highlighted or the cursor will appear at the end of the URL. Click Enter and you will be taken to the Configuration screen; look for the Initial School/District button. Select this and enter your district name and ID and then enter a school and ID. It is recommended that you use IDs that are in compliance with IDs used by your state education agency.
