

Fitnessgram 9 Installation District Windows Server 2003: 32 bit

Are you prepared for Fitnessgram 9 installation?

Is Internet Information Services (IIS) and the .Net Configuration showing up in the Application Server Manager?

Is .NET Framework 3.0 or higher showing up as installed under Add/Remove Programs in the Control Panel?

Do you have Microsoft SQL Server Enterprise or Standard Edition installed on this server?

You have verified the Web Service Extensions for ASP.Net set to Allow.

Does the account doing the installation have full rights (including Create Database rights)?

If the answer to all five of these questions is yes, then please proceed with the installation of Fitnessgram 9.

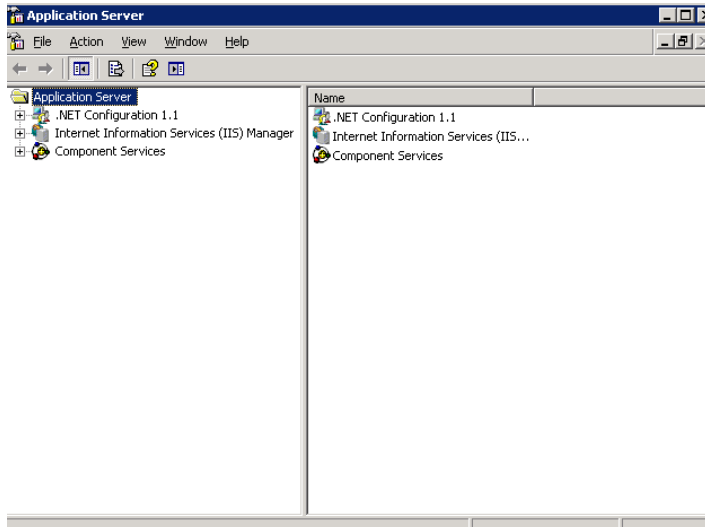
Note: If you are using a 64-bit system, you will need to enable IIS 6.0 to run 32-bit applications. Microsoft's directions for enabling this are as follows.

To enable IIS 6.0 to run 32-bit applications on 64-bit Windows:

- 1. Open a command prompt and navigate to the %systemdrive%\inetpub\AdminScripts directory.*
- 2. Type the following command:
cscript.exe adsutil.vbs set W3SVC/AppPools/Enable32BitAppOnWin64 "true"*
- 3. Press Enter.*

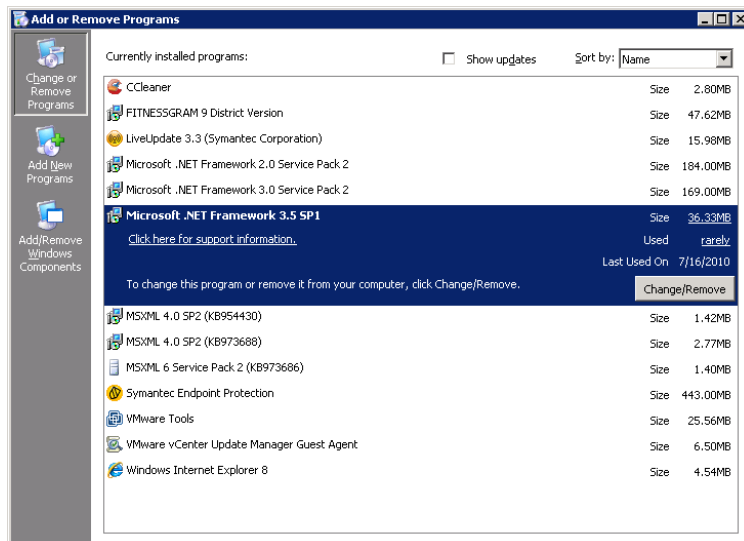
Application Server Manager

If the server is ready for the installation of Fitnessgram 9, the following prerequisites will be listed in the following areas. Internet Information Services (IIS) Manager and .NET Configuration will appear in the Application Server.



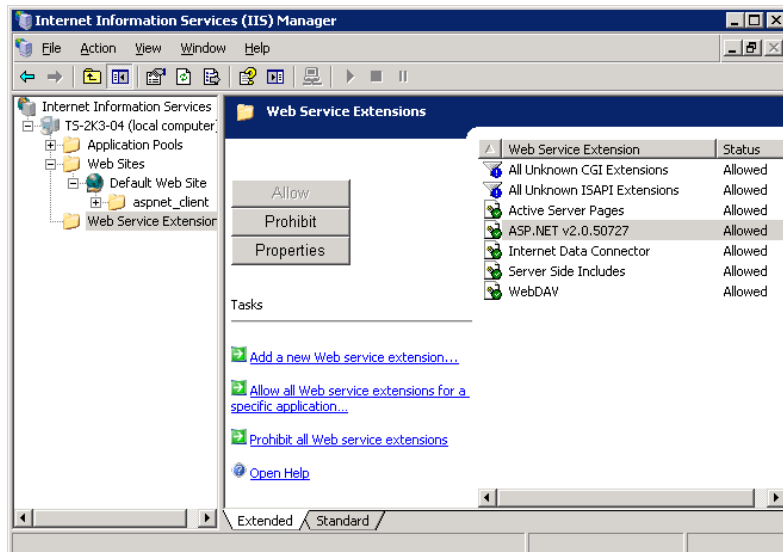
Control Panel

Microsoft .NET Framework 3.0 or higher will be listed in Add/Remove Programs.



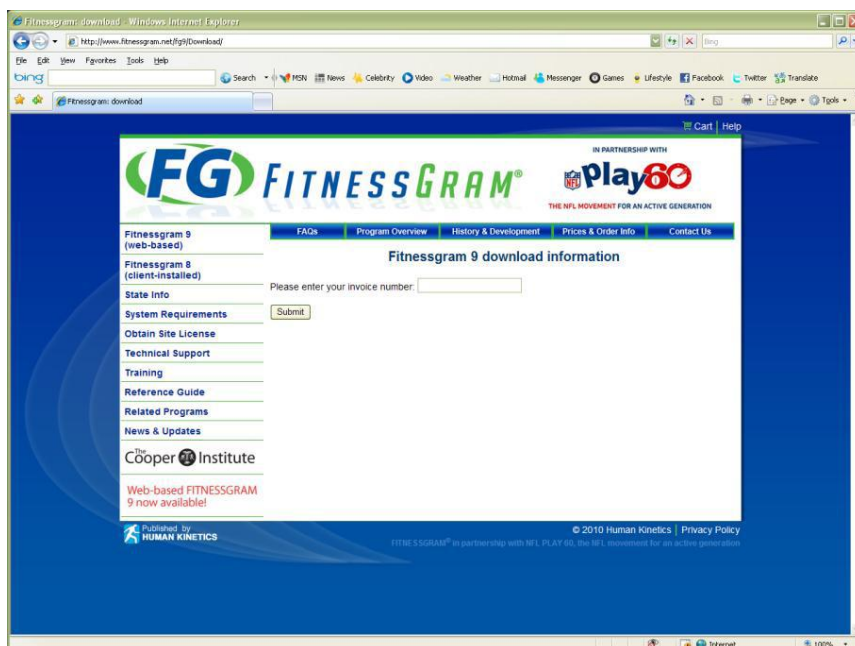
IIS Manager

Web Service Extensions for ASP.Net will be set to Allowed.

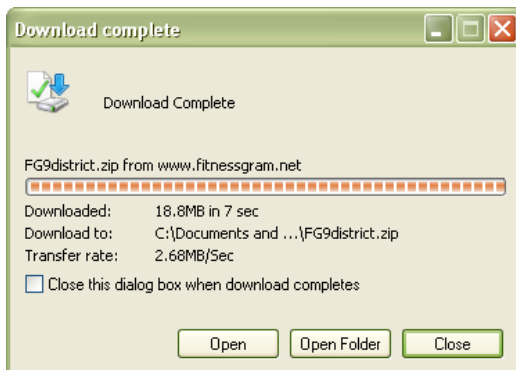
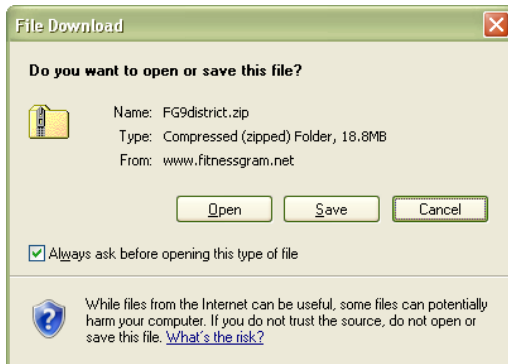
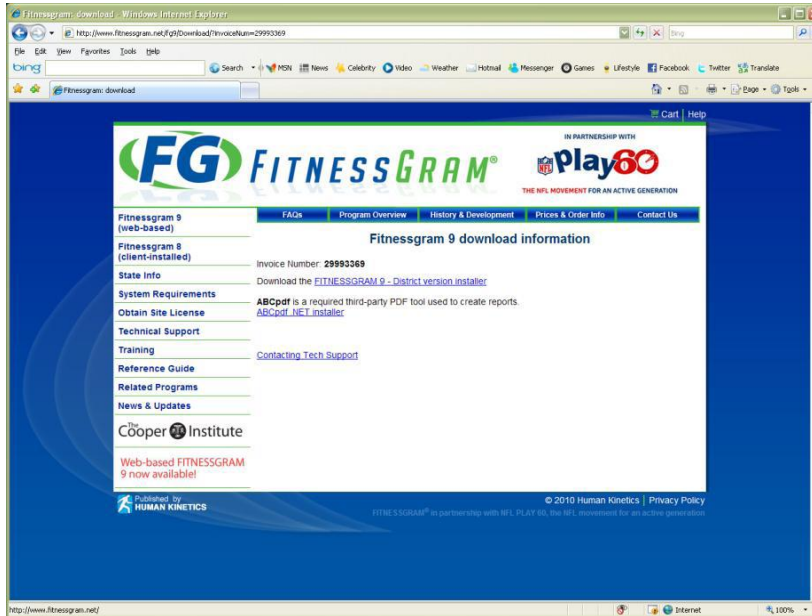


Access to the Fitnessgram 9 installer

Take the invoice number from Human Kinetics for the purchase of Fitnessgram 9, go to www.fitnessgram.net/fg9/Download, enter the number, and choose Submit.



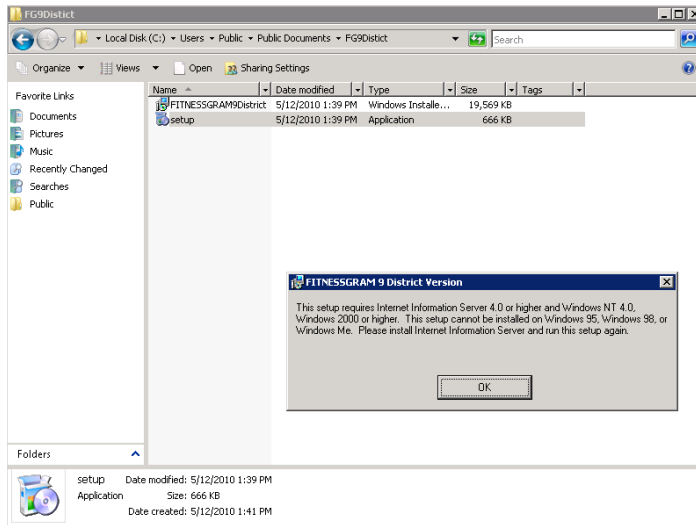
Choose the Fitnessgram 9—District version installer link. When the File Download screen appears, select Save and then choose to save it to your desktop or somewhere on the computer that is easily accessible.



When the download is complete, close the screen.

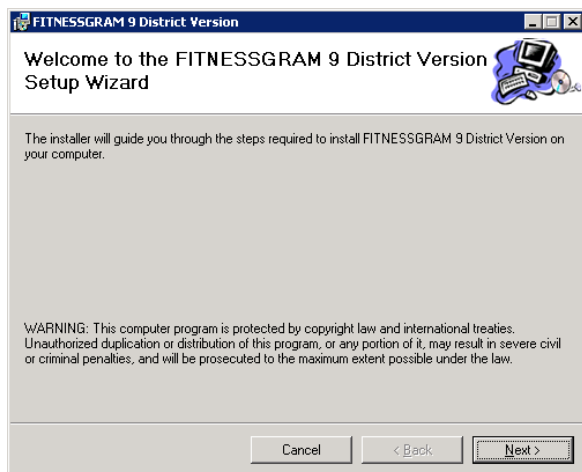
Fitnessgram 9 Installer

When choosing the Fitnessgram 9 installer and starting the installation process, there will be a prompt regarding the program requiring IIS if it is not already installed.

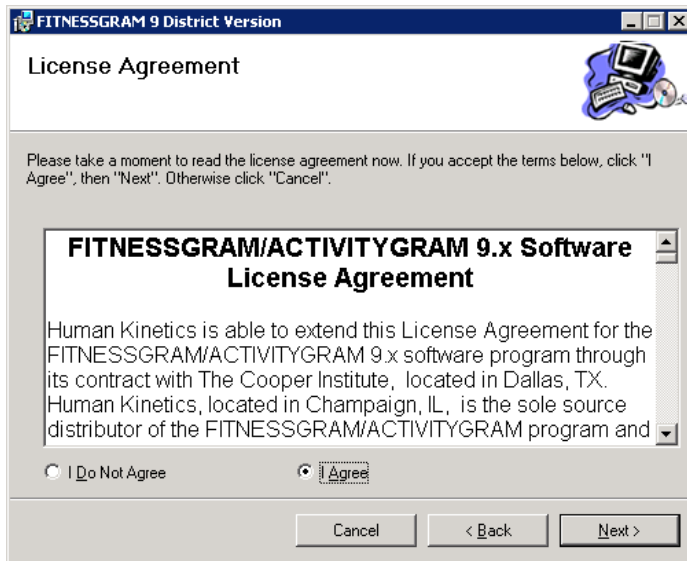


If you get this prompt, you will need to install the IIS and run the setup again.

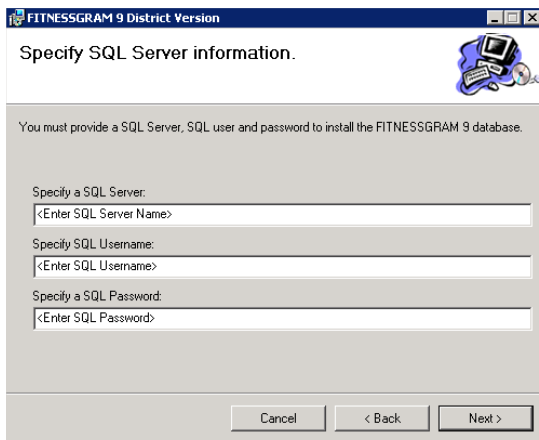
At the Setup Wizard screen, click Next.



On the License Agreement screen, select the button for Agree and then click Next.

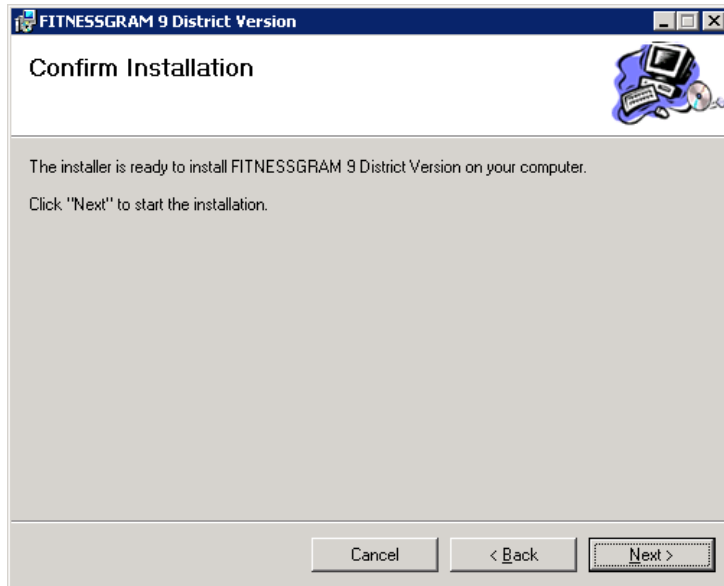


At the Specify SQL Server information screen, you must enter the name of the SQL server, the user name, and password for the server. This is not the FG9 login. Once the information is entered, click Next.

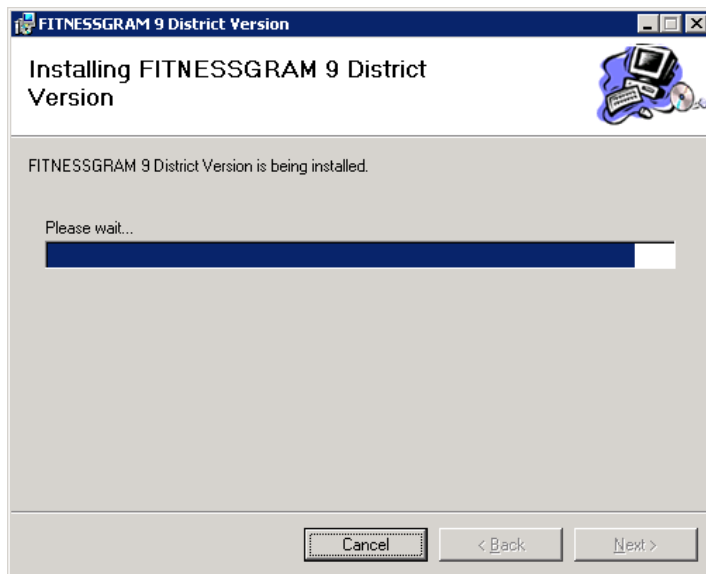


Note: If the server name, user name, and password are not entered, Fitnessgram 9 will not install. If the person doing the installation does not have this information, they will have to contact someone in their IT department or the SQL administrator for the district.

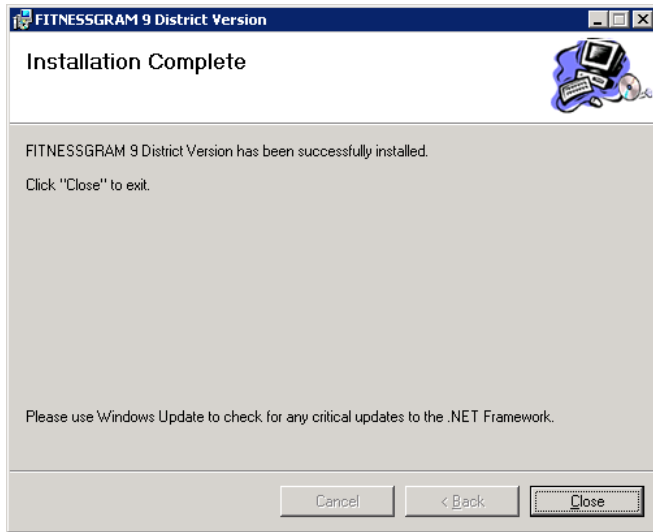
The installer will ask for confirmation that the installation should take place. Click on Next and the installation will begin.



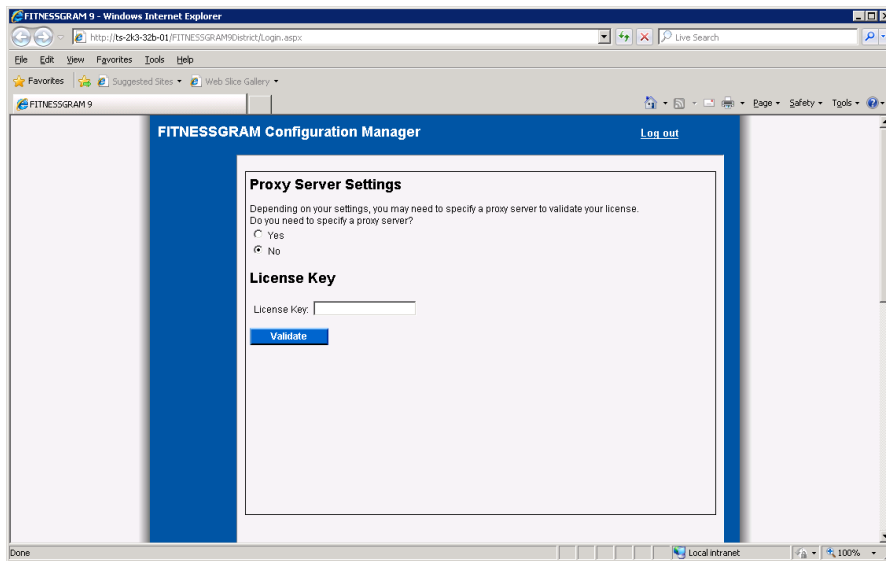
During the installation, a progress bar will display.



Installation is complete when the following screen appears. Then you can close the screen.



The Fitnessgram Configuration Manager will open automatically, and you will enter your license key and select Validate.



Once you see the message that confirms your license key has been validated, it is very important that you place the cursor in the URL field at the top of the page. This is commonly referred to as the address bar. Depending on the browser you are using, the URL will be highlighted or the cursor will appear at the end of the URL. Click Enter and you will be taken to the Configuration screen. Look for the Initial School/District button. Select this and enter your district name and ID and then enter a school and ID. It is recommended that you use IDs that are in compliance with IDs used by your state education agency.
