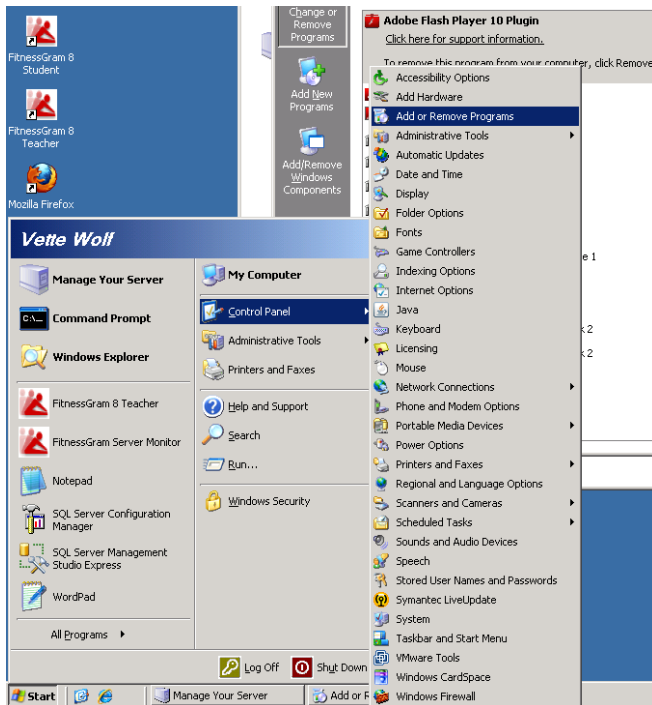


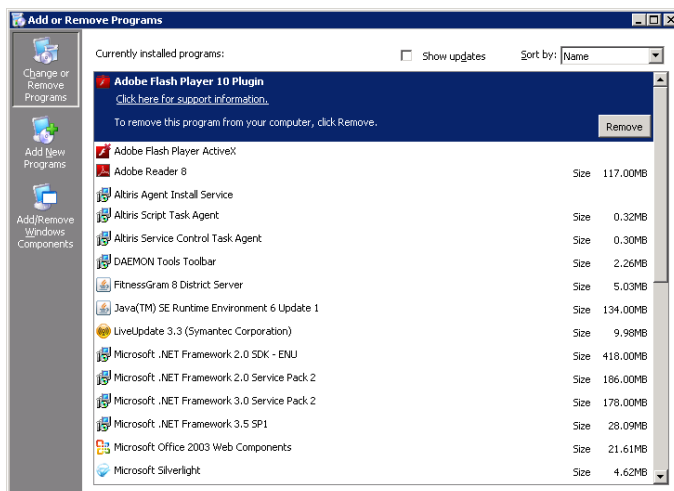
# Windows Server 2003: Enabling ASP.Net Web Extension

To enable ASP.Net Web extension to IIS, follow these steps.

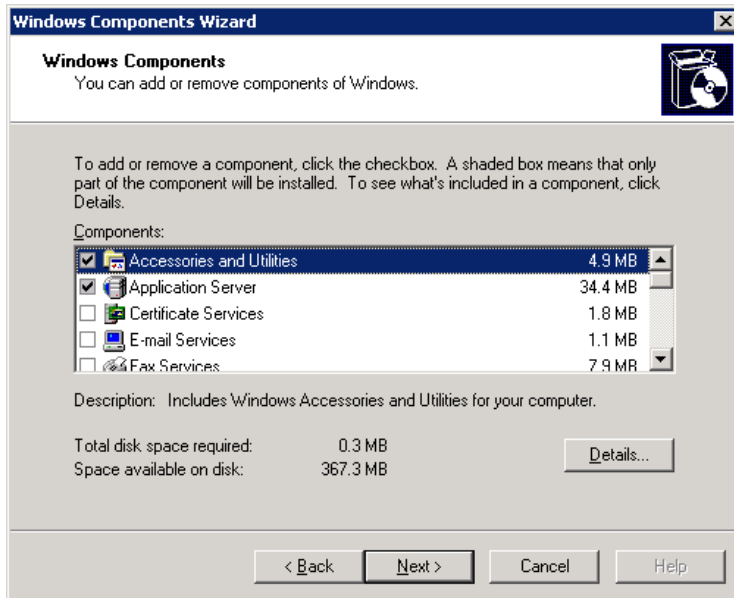
Go to Control Panel. Click on Add or Remove Programs.



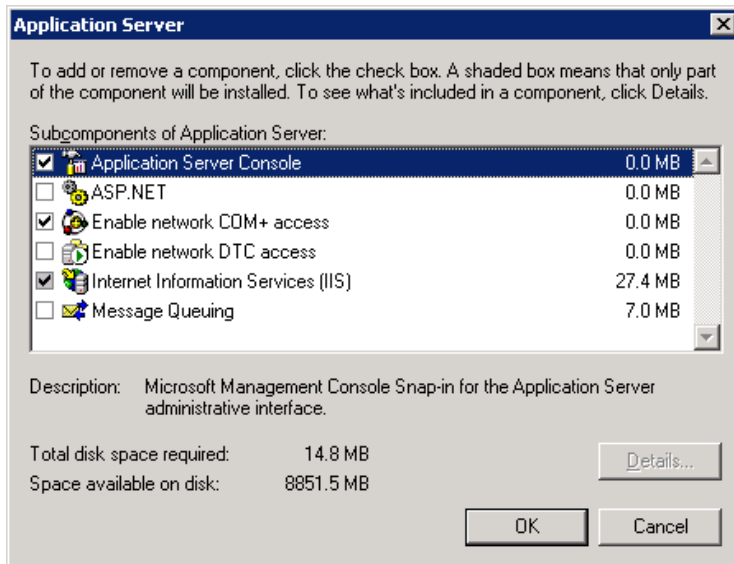
Click on Add/Remove Windows Components on the left navigation bar.



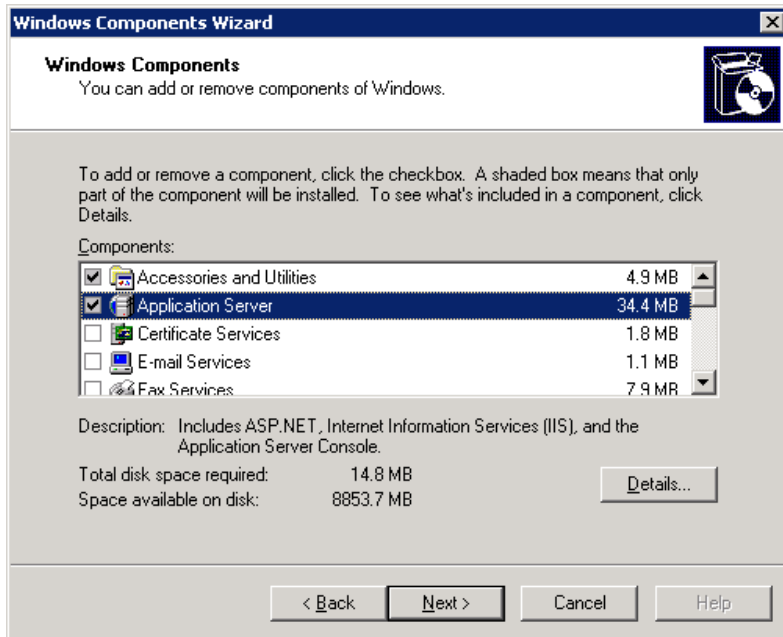
Check the box next to Application Server. Click on Details.



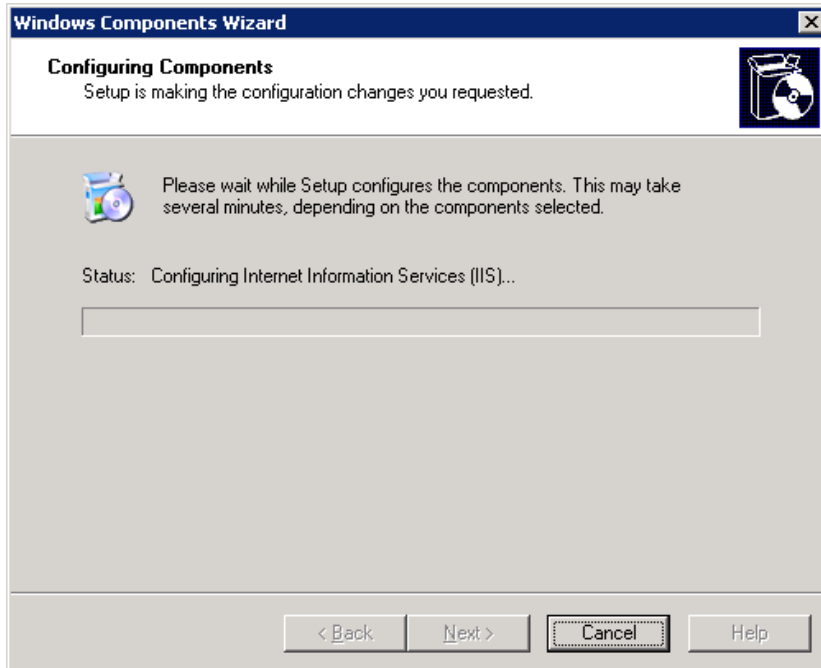
Check the box next to ASP.NET and click OK.



Click the Next button to complete the installation.



The progress bar will scroll through the installation.

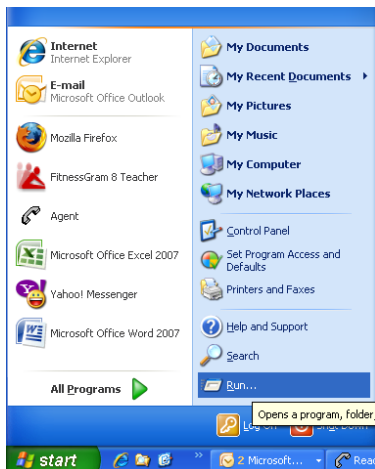


When the installation is complete, click the Finish button to close the wizard.

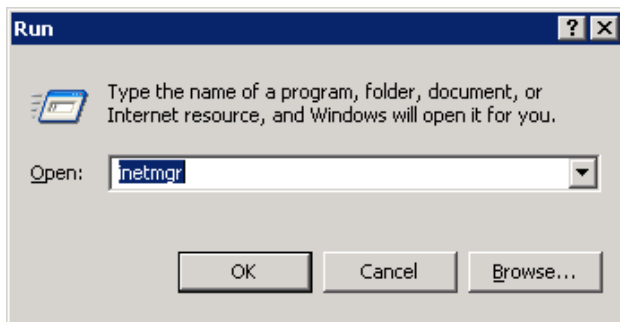


To verify the installation and ensure the ASP.NET Web Extension is set to Allowed, follow these steps.

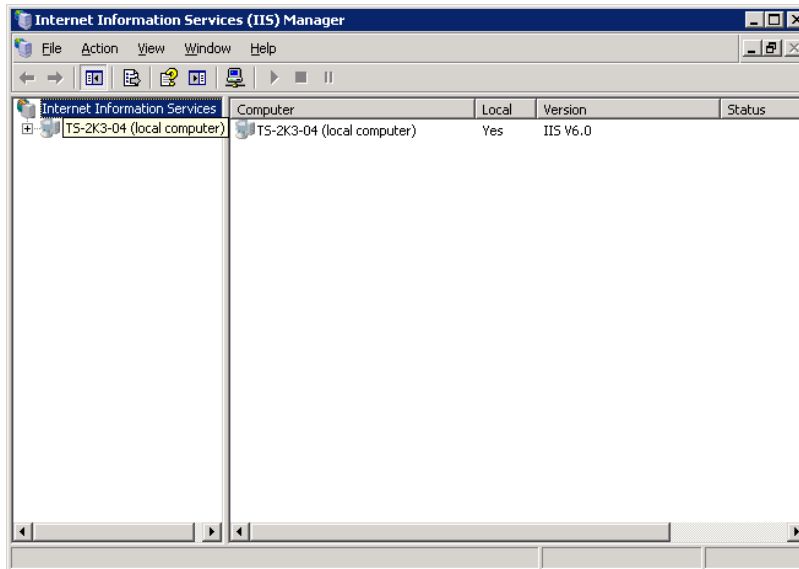
Go to Start/Run on the Windows taskbar.



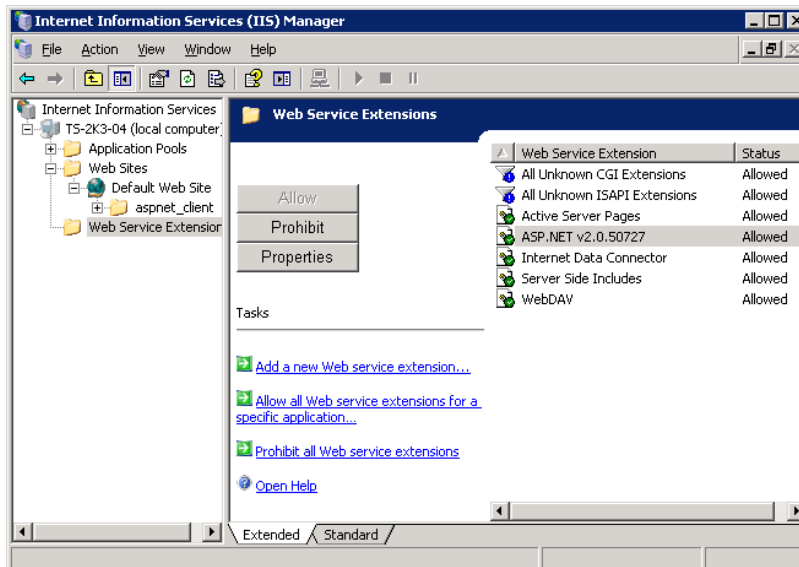
Type in inetmgr and click the OK button.



The IIS Manager will appear. Expand the server by clicking the + sign to the left of the server name.



Click on Web Service Extensions on the left. On the right window, you will see ASP.NET and the version number installed. If the status is set to Prohibited, highlight the ASP.NET and click the Allow button. If the status is set to Allow, then the installation should proceed normally as long as all other prerequisites are met.
